### DO YOU HAVE AN INTEREST IN SERVING ON ANY OF OUR COMMITTEES?

- (C0) Board of Directors**—Makes policy and decisions for overall affiliate. Meets second Monday of every month.
- (C1) Construction Committee**—Organizes and coordinates the design and building of homes. Meets as needed during construction process.
- (C2) Site Selection Committee**—Acquires building sites throughout Clinton County for the affiliate. Meets as needed.
- (C3) Family Selection Committee**—Selects the Habitat partner families. Meets as needed through the selection process. Currently the process occurs approximately over a three-month period early in the year.
- (C4) Family Support Committee**—Supports the partner families by helping them learn to be homeowners. Meets monthly.
- (C5) Public Relations Committee**—Works to inform and educate the public about HFH and housing needs through newsletters, media releases, and other means. Meets as needed.
- (C6) Fundraising**—Raises funds for Habitat through on-going and special events. Meets monthly.
- (C7) Volunteer Coordination**—Matches volunteers to work activity.
- (C8) Church Relations Committee**—Develops and maintains working relationships between Habitat for Humanity of Clinton County and local churches. Meets monthly.

### CAN YOU SERVE IN LEADERSHIP POSITION?

- (L1) Site Supervisor**—Coordinates the entire build. A basic knowledge of all phases of construction is desirable but not mandatory. Must be able to search out and apply solutions in unfamiliar areas.
- (L2) Project Manager**—Coordinates one part of the build. Needs qualifications similar to Site Supervisor, but only in the area being managed.
- (L3) Site Host**—Shows volunteers the work site, introduces workers to other workers, and gets waivers signed. Site host can also help with work when not busy with host duties. A team of two or three people can manage a site on an alternating schedule.
- (L4) Group Liaison**—Represents Habitat in your church or organization to which you belong.

### COULD YOU PROVIDE THE USE OF SOME EQUIPMENT AND RELATED SERVICES?

- (E1) Pickup truck**—moving items, picking up donations, etc.
- (E2) Concrete finishing tools**
- (E3) Shovels and rakes**
- (E4) Wheelbarrow**
- (E5) Skid-steer loader**
- (E6) Dump truck**—moving fill dirt to/from a lot, taking trash to the landfill
- (E7) Front end loader with box scraper or blade for grading**
- (E8) Chipper and/or branch disposal**
- (E9) Pickup or other truck**—taking things to the landfill, hauling wood chips, etc.
- (E10) Lawn seeder**—power or hand
